#### MANAGING THE COURT DURING THE JUDICIAL TRANSITION

The process to get a new judge on the bench continues. Since Judge Sharp's retirement on April 1, local court staff have worked closely with the 7th District Court office in LaCrosse for court coverage by reserve judges. Reserve judges Jenny Day and Michael Kirchman have presided over all of the cases that would have been presided over by Judge Sharp. Additionally, we continue to have court with a number of District 7 judges who were previously assigned to various Richland County cases. We also continue to have court hearings with our family court commissioner Debra Schwarze and various non-family court commissioners assigned to handle Richland County matters when no judges are available. Examples of matters handled by court commissioners include bail hearings on new arrests, injunction hearings in restraining order cases, and review of restraining order petitions. Court commissioners also review search warrants for the district attorney and preside over mental commitments and matters in which a formal petition or complaint has not yet been filed by the state or county.

When we utilize court commissioners, they are paid by the county. When reserve judges preside over our cases, they are paid by the state. During this transition period in between Judge Sharp and the next Richland County Judge, whom the Governor will be appointing, Clerk of Court staff try to have as much done in front of judges as possible to avoid cost to the county.

#### MANAGING RECORDS AND COURT INFORMATION FOLLOWING THE "CCAP 3" IMPLEMENTATION

The creation and management of Richland County's official court records requires constant attention to detail, critical thinking, and utilization of ever-changing state software products. In the Circuit Courts, county staff use state-owned equipment and software to update records, process judgments, set and manage court calendars, assist the public, and collect money due to the county and state. The software used by the courts is called CCAP. It is a secure system with separate features for the management of case records, circuit court accounting, and jury management. CCAP stands for Consolidated Court Automation Programs. CCAP is not the public site that folks use to access Wisconsin's court records online. That site is actually called "Wisconsin Circuit Court Access," though, most often, people incorrectly refer to the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access (WCCA) site as CCAP. The distinction between the two is very important. Circuit Court staff are the only people who have access to the actually CCAP software. They are the only ones who work with the information that creates what the public sees when they go onto Wisconsin Circuit Court Access.

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When I am reporting to the Public Safety Committee and I say "CCAP," I mean the software that is used by court staff. I am not referring to the WCCA internet site accessible by the public to search for case and other court records.

The CCAP software used by all 72 counties is written and managed by a team of hardware and software engineers in Madison. When local court staff have issues with hardware or software, we work with the CCAP folks in Madison to resolve the issues.

In 2021, Wisconsin CCAP started the rollout of the first major case management rewrite that has occurred in the last 20+ years. The platform for which the old CCAP Case Management software was written is no longer easily supported by today's software techs. So the program has received a major overall and is now a web-based platform known as "CCAP 3."

The conversion from the old Case Management to CCAP 3 is a big ordeal. When it happens, CCAP staff come out to the county and work with staff in the early days of the transition. They also makes notes on problems the counties are having using the software and make suggestions for tweaks and rewrites.

When CCAP3 was rolled out last year, it was piloted in Grant County. The Grant County Clerk of Court's office found major issues with the software. Other counties going on the software shortly after Grant County reported many of the same issues. CCAP eventually determined that the software needed to go back to the drawing board and halted the statewide rollout until early this year.

Knowing that we were about to have a judicial transition and knowing how much work the software conversion would be, I requested that the state not schedule our CCAP 3 implementation until after Judge Sharp's retirement.

The complexities of the CCAP 3 implementation vary among staff depending on the case types they work with and types of information they are responsible for. For clerks who work with civil case types and cases that do not have "charges" associated with them, the software is fairly straight-forward. For those who work with criminal and traffic court, however, the new software is a bit of a beast. Much of what criminal clerks were able to do very quickly in court before now takes two to three times longer.

Currently, I serve as the president of the Wisconsin Clerks of Circuit Court Association. Earlier this year, I was appointed by the Wisconsin Director of State Courts to join the CCAP Steering Committee, a body of court officials that includes judges, clerks, and district court administrators who serve as advisors to CCAP. In April, I had the opportunity to address CCAP Steering and provide examples of the difficulties the CCAP 3 software has caused criminal clerks at the county level. I am hopeful the feedback the state is receiving from myself and other clerks will result in some major improvements in the new software.

In the meantime, locally, we are keeping up in court by double-clerking the heavier days of criminal and traffic court. This ties up twice as many staffing resources but it allows us to do all of the things that are demanded of clerks in the courtroom included taking minutes, producing bail bond orders and judgments of conviction, scheduling and notifying parties of court dates, connecting parties for remote appearances, and communicating court orders and other directives to all of the parties and agencies affected by court rulings and procedures.

It is important for county officials to realize how lean the Clerk of Court office operates in Richland County. For everything we do, we constantly analyze all parts of the process and find the most efficient way to do the work. This is something that should not be taken for granted and should be considered when the county board makes decisions that affect budgets and staffing. As a 3-person office, the Richland County Clerk of Court office is the lightest staffed in the entire state. Our staffing level is the same as Forest County, a northern Wisconsin county that shares a judge with another county. No other counties with a full judge and court commissioners have only three people. This is not said as request for more staff, just as a reminder that there is nowhere within the current Clerk of Court office to cut, reduce, or restructure.

#### **MANAGING COURT FINANCES**

The Clerk of Court manages the Circuit Court's budget and serves as financial specialist for both the Clerk of Court and Register in Probate Offices. Using Wisconsin statutes as a guide, the Richland County Clerk of Court collects monies ordered by the Court whether they are willingly paid or not. Statutory fail-to-pay measures used by the Clerk of Court include civil judgment with interest for all debts, driver's license suspension for traffic court debts, State Debt Collection (SDC) for all debts over \$50 including victim restitution, and tax refund interception (TRIP) of debts less than \$50 but more than \$20. Statute allows for arrest warrants as a fail-to-measure as well. However, the Richland County Clerk of Court does not use warrants because it is cost prohibitive for the sheriff to arrest people and hold them for not paying a fine on time.

Clerk of Court revenue, as projected each year in the county's budget process, is a combination of court aid received from the state, fees paid for court services including case filing and copy fees (as examples), and reimbursements collected by the Clerk of Court for attorney fees paid by the county.

For 2022, the Clerk of Court has projected Circuit Court revenue at \$252,358.12. We appear to be on pace to meet that projection.

The attached sheets from the county's ACS Financial System show the money that was collected by the Clerk of Court the first four months of the year.

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April collections by the Circuit Court were disbursed to the County Treasurer after the clerk's monthly reconciling of accounts was complete the first week of May. See thee ACS Financial System reports from the Administrator's office, numbered 5-16.

Pages 17-19, from the Clerk of Court's CCAP Financials Accounting System, show our collection efforts in a different format with detail on the various accounts that we work with inside our department.

2022 Expenditures thus far are captured in the ACS Financial System "Expenditure Guideline" hand-numbered pages 20 and 21.

April 2022 disbursements (bills paid from the Clerk of Court's budget) are listed in hand-numbered pages 22 and 23.

#### MANAGING JURY TRIALS AND JUROR RESOURCES

We have not yet had a jury trial in 2022 though there are still various trials on the calendar, the next possibly as soon as next Thursday. Throughout the summer, we have dozens of trials scheduled, though it is anticipated most of those cases will settle prior to trial.

#### PREPARING TO ONBOARD THE NEXT JUDGE

As I have said before, the Clerk of Court office is the cog that moves the wheel. Our office is and will continue to be at the center of everything that transpires in the Court. When we are polished and prepared, so too is the Court.

Once we have a new judge on the bench, I plan to sit down with them and explain our budget and how various orders of the Court affect our financial bottom line. Beyond salaries, the largest expense in the Circuit Court budget is that of court-appointed attorney fees. It is critically important that the next judge require and carefully consider the financial disclosure information of persons who apply for court-appointed counsel. At a Supreme Court rate of \$100 per hour, it does not take long for the bills to become large and have an incredible impact on the Circuit Court budget. As the county board and county administrator look for places to cut, they should be aware that this is an expense the courts cannot avoid. However, it is one we will continue to carefully manage.
